# Comments:

Swan 56-012 is an absolute head turner with the mix of modern-classic lines and beautiful midnight blue hull.

Originally build as a luxury cruising yacht for a family but with the potential to participate in regattas around the world with success.

She has the standard Swan 56 interior layout with owners cabin in front of the mast, with the very nice option, a separate shower cabin opposite the forward head. Two aft cabins and one crew cabin in front.

She is build with the High Performance Keel, the keel the Swan 56 was originally designed with, 390 kg heavier compared to the shallower keel, with a stronger keel frame and a shorter installation surface against the hull, more weights further down the keel. The center of gravity is 45 cm deeper down than the shallow draft keel, makes a significant difference in stability and upwind performance!

Ex "Desir Bleu" spend her first year in Monaco. In the winter 00/01 she was bought by an Italian living in New York and renamed to "Nova". He researched, with help of Nautor Swan USA, all built Swan 56 for the lightest hull built and found Swan 56-012 on of the lightest with the High Performance Keel and offered the owner a fair price.

It was originally a two year project waiting for his new Swan 80 to be build, but he kept "Nova" beside his other yachts until 2014.

2001 "Nova" received a complete Harken deck equipment update to the absolutely latest for competitive racing, the hull was faired with long boards for perfect hydrodynamic, keel and rudder was with laser measured for exact symmetry.

The standard Swan 56 aluminum rig have hade some problems from start and a new Offshore Spare Intermediate Modulus Carbon Fiber Spare was ordered and is one of only two Swan 56 with this High Performance Option.

Intermediate Modulus Carbon Fiber is stiffer and stronger than standard Carbon Fiber,

approximately 150kg lighter then the std aluminum mast.

OBS! Same dimension as her original Mast Head aluminum rig and NOT the bigger regatta fractional rig some Swan 56 have.

"Nova" was based in the Newport area with a full time skipper until 2010, mostly moored outside the owners summer house on Long Island and only raced in a few NYYC races the following years.

The combination of the High Performance Keel and the Intermediate Modulus Carbon Fiber Spars makes her to a perfect cruising boat with small crew.

The increasing in the righting moment is significant and the improvement in upwind and overall performance is considerable compared to the shallower keel/aluminum mast. From 2010 to 2014 she was stored on land at NEB in Newport. In August 2014 the current owner

From 2010 to 2014 she was stored on land at NEB in Newport. In August 2014 the current owner bought her and renamed her to Amoress 3.

Amoress 3 is the current owners third Swan and he did a comprehensive refit in Newport with new generator, new JP3 rudder bearing with a new composite bearing house, varnish works of her interior and much more, before he left for a winter in Caribbean.

Amoress 3 did her first and only transatlantic on own keel in may 2015 to Europe. The owner have used her for family sailing, with a small crew or single handed.

The current owner have had some "must have" options when he bought Amoress 3:

- 1. Carbon Mast, no need of baby stay. Easy tacking and storage of dingy on deck.
- 2. High Performance Keel, the shallower keel makes the Swan 56 on the limit too weak.
- 3. The bigger generator 12.5/9.4KW, for high load and shortest possible running time.
- 4. Foldable transom door/platform for swimming, not all Swan 56 have this option. For warm water sailing this is a must and for racing this can be changed to a carbon fixed door to eliminate weight.
- 5. Owners cabin with separate shower cabin. Only a few Swan 56 have this option.

Beautifully maintained and upgraded with an extended refit 2023/24: New painted hull with Awlgrip, midnight blue. New antifouling. New PSS shaft seal rubber bellows and o-rings. The varnished teak interior in mint condition and have every winter small touch up where it needs. Motor and generator service: oil, filter, diesel filters, impellers, cleaning heat exchangers and changed glycol. All tanks cleaned inside manually. All Blakes seacocks serviced. All winches serviced. New sump pump forward toilet. Both toilets full service with new hoses. New water pressure pump. New anchor roller. New hatch locker. Rod rig survey by QI Composite visual and ultrasound NDT 2024 with certificate. Mast out for service and inspection 2024. Reckmann furling serviced and new bearings and sliders 2024. New water heater 2024 New Mastervolt Mass 24/100 charger 2024 New Mast jack 2024

Amoress 3 is set up for Mediterranean/Caribbean performance cruising with a short handed crew or even single handed in maximum comfort.

With little preparation Amoress 3 have potential to do a top result in any Swan regatta in the world and capable of a ARC crossing Las Palmas/St Lucia in 12 days.

Amoress 3 is in immaculate condition and ready for the coming summer in the Mediterranean or to go anywhere in the world with short notice and minimum preparation. She was originally build for both 230/115 volt, 50/60 Hz so no limits in cruising areas.

## HULL

Hull midnight blue with white stripes.

Painted with awlgrip November 2022

Antifouling is always sanded before antifouling to a smooth thin layer of antifouling (and no building up layers which later falling partly off.)

Keel joint rebuilt and tightened.

Transom door with bathing ladder and hand shower.

New transom door hydraulic in 2014.

Transom door hinges updated to stainless steel new 2015.

New rudder bearing JP3 and bearing house rebuilt to composite housing and new sleeve Nov.2014. Serviced 2019

## DECK

Teak deck on coamings and side deck in good condition. Teak toe rail, unvarnished. Jib track Harken New 2016. Radar pole. Chrome dorado vents on coach roof. Lifeline gates on both sides. New moose skin on the steering wheel.


